**PLEASE CONSIDER THESE IMPORTANT PROGRAM DETAILS:**

☑ Our Term consists of 20 sessions (per classroom) taught twice per week for 10 weeks, and during regular class time. Each session is of 50-minutes duration. Ballroom Dance is interwoven with key components of the academic curriculum. Character Education is the primary focus, dance is the joyful tool.

☑ We require a minimum of 2 Classrooms in a school with sessions conducted Back to Back for program purpose and efficiency. Kindly indicate number of student p/class to a maximum of 30.

☑ An In-School Showcase culminates the term. Competing Events are optional. We do strongly encourage schools to participate in these celebratory and life affirming experiences for their students and community. There is NO Competition process presently for the newly introduced Grade 7/8 and Advanced Programs.

☑ Dancing Classrooms is based on a 50/50 community shared responsibility approach. As of 2009/10 schools will pay the 50% of the actual total cost. JTD is committed to seeking the remainder from corporate and philanthropic sponsorships, private donations, fundraising events, and grants.

☑ School's Cost: \$3,850 for 2 classrooms of up to 30 students PER Class. Each Additional Class is \$1925 Per Class. A school's average cost per child for 20 sessions of 50 minutes duration is \$64.17 or \$3.21 per session. JTD & Dancing Classrooms are registered not for profit charities.
